Careers Information

All students are required to stay in some form of education or training until the end of the year that they turn 18, below is a summary of options available at post 16 & 18.

A-Levels – You typically study 3 A-levels over two years. To study A-levels, you usually need at least 5 GCSEs at Grade 5, including English and Maths. You may need higher grades in some subjects. For example, at Edgbarrow to access A-level courses students will have a minimum of five Grade 5 passes and a Grade 6 in a facilitating subject (or the equivalent Level 2 qualifications). The Facilitating subject and grade requirement depend on the course, it may be Grade 6 in that subject or a similar specified subject(s), e.g. History or English Language. However, a small number of courses require higher grades, to study Maths at Edgbarrow you will need a GCSE Maths Grade 7. Students should always check course requirements as these will differ between different educational establishments. A-levels are generally exam-based courses with very little (20%) or no coursework. Progression is either to university, a full-time job or onto an advanced or higher apprenticeship.

Vocational Pathways – These are more practical courses than A-Levels, they prepare you for work in a specific job sector. You study one subject in depth and develop relevant practical skills. Assessment is more varied (practical/projects/portfolios, etc.) and there are few exams. There are links to work experience opportunities. Progression is into a full-time job, an advanced or higher apprenticeship or university.

Apprenticeships – Earn while you learn. These are typically 4 days of work and 1 day of studying per week. There are various levels, you can find more information via the following website: <https://amazingapprenticeships.com/>. You can search and register for notifications on apprenticeships at the following website <https://www.gov.uk/apply-apprenticeship>. Not all companies advertise via this website, so you will need to research individual companies as well, particularly for higher-level apprenticeships. Higher-level apprenticeships are Levels 4-7 and degree apprenticeships are levels 6&7, they combine work with study and may include a work-based, academic or combined qualification or a professional qualification relevant to the industry. T-Levels follow GCSEs and are equivalent to 3 A-Levels. These 2-year courses were developed in collaboration with employers and businesses to meet the needs of industry and prepare students for work. They include classroom learning and 'on-the-job' experience with an industry placement of 45 days. They provide the knowledge and experience needed to open the door to skilled employment, further study or a higher apprenticeship.
