



Our Subject Intent

In Philosophy, Ethics and Religion, we aim to inspire students to become independent critical thinkers who can communicate effectively with others. We examine a diverse range of spiritual, moral, philosophical and cultural beliefs and practices, which help our students to develop their own views and teaches them to respect the views of others.











Our core values

- 1. **Ready**: We aim to <u>ready</u> students for successful participation in wider society when they leave us, by exploring a variety of cultural, spiritual and moral perspectives that inform student's own beliefs and values.
- 2. **Respectful**: We aim to teach students the importance of being <u>respectful</u> of the views and beliefs of others, by fostering an environment where every view is expressed and responded to sensitively.
- Safe: We aim to create a <u>safe</u> space for students to learn, where the contribution of every student is valued and everyone is supported to fulfil their potential.
- 4. **Positive**: We aim to deliver <u>positive</u> learning experiences through our inclusive curriculum, which is based on choice and challenge and allows all students to participate and succeed.







Our Curriculum

We aim to offer our students a broad, enquiry-based curriculum that invites them to critically explore the beliefs and practices of the major world faiths and deepen their understanding of a variety of moral, spiritual, philosophical and cultural worldviews.

Key content	Key skills
Spirituality : We investigate core spiritual questions such as whether human beings have a soul, if there is an afterlife and what could be considered the meaning of life.	Critical thinking: We foster a critical and questioning approach to unpacking topics of morality and faith, which develop student's analysis and evaluation skills.
Morality: We examine moral questions such as how to treat other people, what could be considered right and wrong and study a variety of responses to ethical issues, such as human interaction with the environment.	Communication: Students learn to communicate effectively by being encouraged to develop their reading, writing, oracy and listening skills, such as through the P4C pedagogy.
Beliefs : We explore the foundation of religious beliefs, such as the nature of God and Judgement and the role of prophets in religion.	Perspectives: By tackling existential questions which do not have definitive answers and require abstract thinking, students learn to justify their answers and challenge different perspectives.
Practices : We study religious practices such as worship, as well as expressions of belonging with a focus on charity and community.	











Our Pedagogy

- 1. **Respect:** We foster a safe and inclusive learning environment built on mutual respect and positive relationships, by encouraging all staff and students to contribute to learning.
- 2. **Ambition**: We challenge all staff and students to exceed expectations by consistently providing opportunities to deepen understanding of knowledge and skills.
- 3. **Reflection:** We provide regular opportunities for staff and students to receive feedback and reflect on how to improve further, including through developing our meta-cognition.
- 4. **Deep Learning**: We design our curriculum to ensure subject content and skills are successfully transferred into long-term memory through careful sequencing, interleaving, recall and practice opportunities.
- 5. **Success for All**: We support all learners and staff to achieve and exceed their potential by providing appropriate support and challenge at every stage of progress
- 6. **A thirst for Learning**: We encourage staff and students to become life-long learners who think critically and creatively and are motivated to continue to improve.
- 7. **Clarity and Consistency**: We approach learning collaboratively within the framework of whole school and agreed department structures to ensure that staff and students consistently meet and exceed our expectations.
