There are 5 bullet points you are given a prompt in French of what to say

Where you see ! – you have to answer an unprepared question (listen for key words)

Where you see ? you have to ask me a question about the subject given

**REMEMBER !** Each task will require the past, present and future tense for at least one of the bullet points so use this checklist :

Past?

Present?

Future?

Opinion?

Question forms?

### **Key questions for Role Play tasks**

Est-ce que ...

Turns a sentence into a question!

Think around the question to rephrase it in a way that you have the vocabulary:

"Ask if there is a dress code" – it's probably not dress + code so think laterally

### **Picture Based Task**

There are 5 bullet points in this task, they will cover 3 time frames so make sure you check which is:

Past (tu as fait / tu es allé récemment / une occasion qui a été ...)

Present – opinion / normalement / d'habitude

Future – a l'avenir / future tense – tu feras / conditional tense – tu aimerais

Bullet 1 is always 'Décris la photo'

**P** eople

**A** ction

**L** ocation

**M** ood / weather

Sur la photo il y a ...

Je vois ...

A mon avis

Je pense que ...

Je crois que ...

Il me semble que ...

Don't forget when describing people use the 3<sup>rd</sup> person verbs:

Ils sont, ils font, ils prennent, ils aiment, ils jouent, ils mangent etc.

One bullet point will be 'unknown' - you can predict the topic by thinking about the other bullet points – it will be on the same theme. If you haven't had to use one of your tenses it will probably use that time frame so you can prepare some of your recyclable phrases (je suis allé/j'ai fait, je vais/je fais/je suis, je vais aller/je ferai etc.)
