



SO WHAT IS ADVIZA AND HOW CAN WE HELP YOU?

What is Adviza?

A government organisation that provides free advice, guidance and support for all 13-19 year olds.

What is a Personal Adviser (PA)?

This is the person in school that provides one-to-one or group support to the students. There are 2 kinds of Personal Advisers:

- **Education** – PA offers information to all year 11s through one-to-one meetings, group sessions, assemblies and during PSHE lessons.
- **Intensive** – PA has a small caseload of clients that they see many times for intensive support.

Why are students taken out of lessons for Adviza interviews?

Our intention is to help find the right post-16 options for all students and guide them in the right direction. We also see many Year 10s and students from other years that may need some additional support.

Who can refer to Adviza?

We see as many Year 11s as we can but prioritise at the request of any staff in school and are happy to have referrals from staff if they feel a one-to-one guidance interview would be beneficial, or parents/carers can also email in and request this.

Where can we be found?

Personal Advisers are based in the Careers' office in the main school library. Intensive PAs are based in Student Support but may also be visiting young people at home or in the community.
