What is Adviza?

Adviza is a registered charity inspiring people to make better decisions that help them progress in learning and work. Our passion is to support young people at important times in their lives when they have to make key decisions.

The role of a Careers Coach?

Students will learn about their options for after year 11 and will have the opportunity to discuss their interests and career ideas with an independent adviser. Students will have 1-2-1 or group support.

Why are students taken out of lessons for Adviza interviews?

Our intention is to help find the right post-16 options for all students and guide them in the right direction. We also see Year 10s and students from other years that may need some additional support. There is a statutory requirement for all students to receive personal guidance during Year 11.

Who can refer to Adviza?

Any member of school staff can request an appointment as can parent/carers.

Where can we be found?

The Careers Coach is based in the main school library. The Careers coach will also be available to provide guidance during some Student Progress Evenings and at the annual Careers Convention.
