Entry Criteria

- 17 to apply, 18 to commence training
- 6 GCSE's at A- C (5-9) or above, including English Language, Mathematics and a Science subject (single or double award) excluding general studies and critical thinking
- To hold an UK CAA Class 1 flight crew medical
- Height will be between 1.57m (5'2") and 1.91m (6'3") [Taller may be considered subject to a functionality assessment]
- A good level of physical fitness, and ability to satisfy the British Airways medical requirements
- To be able to achieve ICAO Level 6 proficiency in English language
- Right to live and work in the UK
- A valid passport (with minimum of 12 months before expiry date) allowing unrestricted worldwide travel
- No visible tattoos
- Clear criminal record check, referencing history, social media checks
