<u>History – Resources for Year 11 into 12 to be reading</u>

In History there are two main topic areas:

- 1. Tudors, 1485-1603
- 2. Weimar and Nazi Germany, 1918-45

All the following resources will help you gain a good overview of both topics as you look to start in September 2020.

1. Tudors, 1485-1603

- a) This task should be your top priority to gain an understanding of the Tudor period. It is a course from **FUTURE LEARN** on the **TUDORS**, it is provided by the University of Roehampton. It is a 6-week programme of study, there are videos to watch and articles to read. There are also short activities to check your comprehension. - c) On KINDLE there is a book called: "A very short introduction to the Tudors", it is about £5 and a very easy read.
- d) A specific book by John Guy is called "The Tudors", this is a longer book, but worth pushing yourself to read it in coming months.

2. Weimar and Nazi Germany, 1918-45

- a) You could read anything by Ian Kershaw who is an authority on this period.
- b) On KINDLE there is a book called: "A very short introduction to Nazi Germany", it is about £5 and a very easy read.
- c) A specific book by Eric D Weitz is 'Weimar Germany Promise and tragedy'. The first chapters in particular give a nice overview of what life in Weimar Germany was like, it is more expensive at about £17.
