English	The following topics are not studied at Edgbarrow School: • Annie John • Julius Caesar • Oliver Twist	The available topics that are relevant to your course are: • A Christmas Carol • An inspector calls • AQA power and conflict poetry • Macbeth • Romeo and Juliette If students wish to revise their Shakespeare play, they should choose Romeo and Juliet OR Macbeth, depending on which they have been taught.
Maths	 We would advise against studying the topics: Solving linear simultaneous equations algebraically Solving linear simultaneous equations graphically 	We would recommend that students focus on topics that aren't labelled 'Pre-A level'.
Science	All topics are relevant.	Chemistry - All topics are relevant. Physics - All topics for higher tier are relevant. Foundation students do not need to study the Space FT module. Biology – No need to study Infection and Response. Combined Science – All relevant.
History	All topics are relevant.	Medicine Through Time is the only relevant topic.
Geography	All topics are relevant.	All topics are relevant.
