In 2010 after an audit of the CEAIG curriculum the decision was taken to make a public commitment towards CEIAG by working towards the 'Investor in Careers' quality award. The school achieved this in March 2011, the award was valid for 3 years and Edgbarrow were successfully reassessed in April 2014 and May 2017. This award is now due to expire in May 2020 and following further evaluation by the Senior Leadership Team, School Governors and the wider school community and in line with DFE guidance (*Statutory Careers guidance and access for education and training providers (DFE 2018)*); that strongly recommends that all schools should aim to achieve accreditation under the Quality in Careers Standard Award (para. 22, p16) Edgbarrow will be allocating the necessary resources for reassessment. This decision is further supported by the school striving towards achieving all eight Gatsby Career Benchmarks by September 2020.
